

## **TOURNAMENT FORMATS**

**Low Net** - Total gross score for the round, subtract total handicap strokes and record total net score for the tournament.

**T” & “F”** – Play your ball – only holes that start with “T” and “F will be counted.

**NOSE HOLES** – Only holes # 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 16, 17, & 18 will count for the event.

**MUTT & JEFF** – Best Ball totals on each Par 3 and Par 5 count as score.

**TRUE STEP ASIDE SCRAMBLE** – Team Event in which each player tees off on the first hole only, the best shot is selected, and the player whose shot is selected “steps aside” and doesn’t get to play the 2nd shot. The “step aside” continues into the hole. The person who putts the hole must “step aside” on the 1<sup>st</sup> shot of the next hole

**THREE BLIND MICE** – Pro shop randomly draws 3 holes after the round is completed. Scores for those 3 holes are thrown out to tabulate players final tournament score.

**STABLEFORD** – Individual players get 1 point for a Net Bogey, 2 for a Net Par, 3 for a Net Bird and 4 for a Net Eagle.

**Beat the Pro-** Ladies must beat the Pro’s Gross score with their Net score.

**EVEN HOLES** – Only even holes will count for tournament play.

**HOUSE OF CARDS** – Team event, play cards on green plus joker for score.

**BAKERS DOZEN** – Best 13 Hole scores (for 18 Holes) or Best 5 Hole scores (for 9 Holes) will count for the final tournament score.

**RED VS BLUE** – Team net event. Entire field is divided into two teams

**ODD HOLES COUNT-** – Odd holes are counted for weekly tournament.

**RINGERS** – Players improve their score on each hole over 2 weeks.

**SCRAMBLE** – Team event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot.

**THROW OUT 3** - Individual players ERASE their **THREE** highest individual hole scores.

**TEE to GREEN** – Only strokes taken from the tee to the green are counted for tournament

**Co-Ed Golf (WWGA/WMGA) Tournament** – Team event played with members of the WMGA

**All tournaments are played under USGA Rules except where modified by local Westlake rules.**

**All groups must have the official scorecard signed, attested and dated with the score total. Failure to do so disqualifies the players involved.**

**All decisions by Committee/Head Pro are final.**
